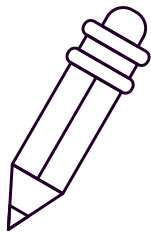


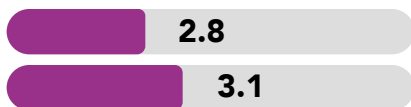

Durham County



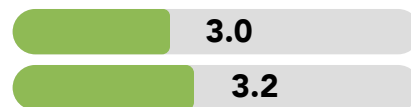
In Durham, the per-pupil expenditure in public elementary and secondary schools is **\$10,527**, compared to **\$9,654** in North Carolina².

MATH SCORES¹

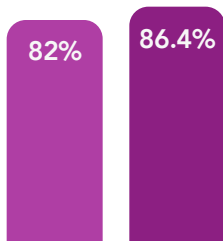


In Durham, the average grade level performance for 3rd graders on math standardized tests is **2.8**, compared to **3.1** in North Carolina.

READING SCORES¹

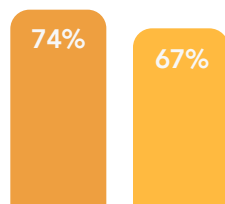


In Durham, the average grade level performance for 3rd graders on English Language Arts standardized tests is **3.0**, compared to **3.2** in North Carolina.



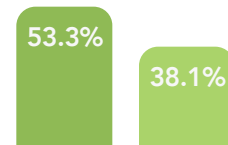
High School Graduation²:

74% of adults have some post-secondary education in Durham, compared to **67%** in North Carolina.

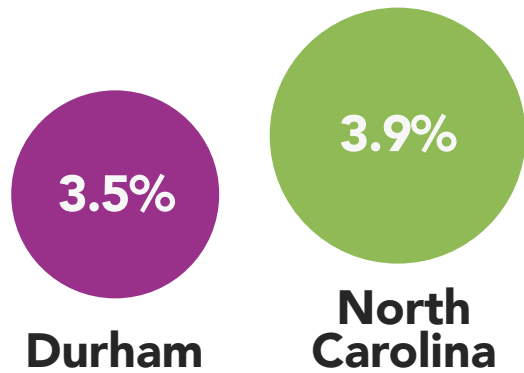


Advanced Degree²:

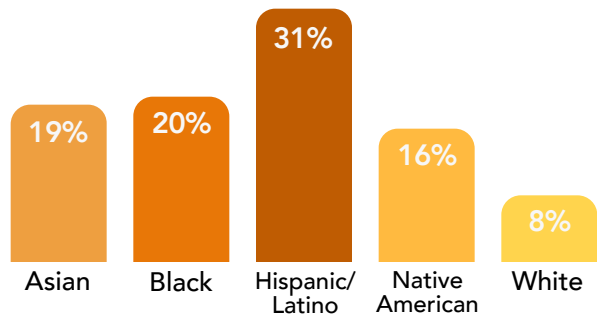
53% of those age 25 and older have an advanced degree in Durham, compared to **38.1%** in North Carolina.

MEDIAN INCOME¹

The income where half of households in a county earn more and half of households earn less. Durham's median is **\$59,300** compared to **\$53,900** for North Carolina.



INCOME INEQUALITY¹

Ratio of household income at the 80th percentile to income at the 20th percentile. Durham is **4.8**, compared to **4.8** for North Carolina as well.
